$$\frac{2}{3} + \frac{5}{7} = \frac{29}{21}$$

$$\frac{3}{4} + \frac{5}{8} = \frac{11}{8}$$

$$\frac{1}{2} + \frac{4}{7} = \frac{15}{14}$$

$$\frac{1}{2} + \frac{5}{7} = \frac{17}{14}$$

$$\frac{4}{5} + \frac{4}{6} = \frac{22}{15}$$

$$\frac{5}{8} + \frac{3}{4} = \frac{11}{8}$$

$$\frac{4}{7} + \frac{1}{2} = \frac{15}{14}$$

$$\frac{2}{3} + \frac{3}{5} = \frac{19}{15}$$

$$\frac{1}{3} + \frac{6}{8} = \frac{13}{12}$$

$$\frac{4}{7} + \frac{2}{3} = \frac{26}{21}$$

$$\frac{5}{7} + \frac{1}{3} = \frac{22}{21}$$

$$\frac{2}{3} + \frac{1}{2} = \frac{7}{6}$$

$$\frac{4}{5} + \frac{5}{6} = \frac{49}{30}$$

$$\frac{2}{3} + \frac{2}{5} = \frac{16}{15}$$
